



Langdon Library Lock-In: August 15 – 16, 2023 Teen Permission Form

On Tuesday, August 15, starting at 8:00PM, through Wednesday, August 16, at 8:00 AM, the Langdon Public Library in Newington will host its first lock-in at the library event, for teens age 13 - 19.

Teens may arrive at 6:30PM for pizza and must be in the building by 8:00 PM when the library closes. ***Late arrivals will not be permitted.***

For safety reasons, participants will not be allowed to leave early, unless prior arrangements are made and except in cases of emergency or illness. Students may be picked up starting at 7:00 AM and must be picked up no later than 8:15 AM. When arriving and departing, teens must check in with the designated librarian and be picked up and dropped off within the building.

Additionally, signed permission slips are required for all attendees and must be turned in by a parent or legal guardian. Slips can either be submitted in advance at the desk or turned in on the night of the lock-in.

TEEN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a participant of the “Langdon Library Lock-In” event on August 15, 2023, I agree to respect the library, my fellow program participants, and library staff. I understand that I must follow all staff instructions and abide by library policies.
